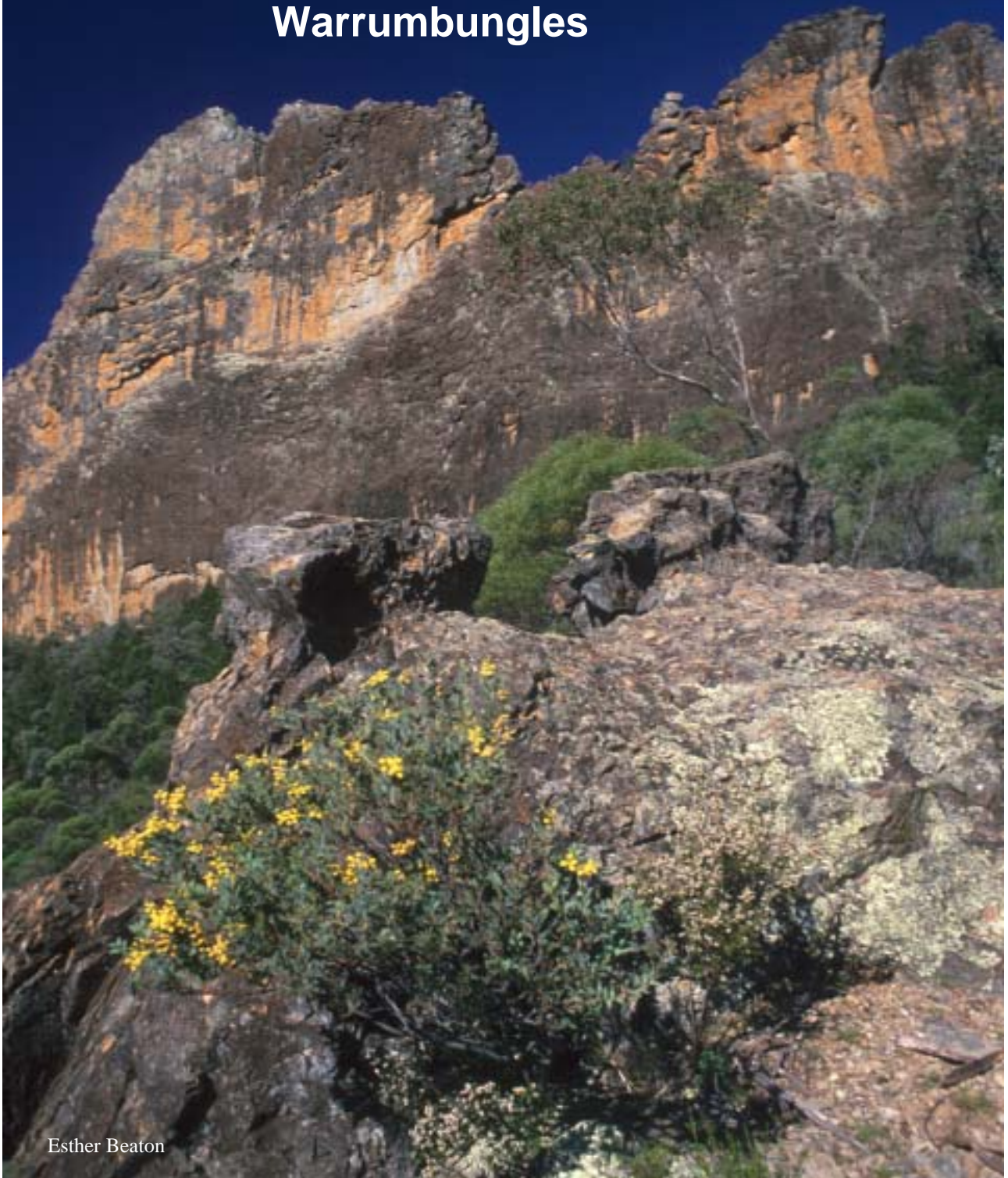


Discover nature photography in the Warrumbungles

workshop from April 23-25.*



This is a unique opportunity to discover the beautiful Warrumbungle National Park and take a fresh look at it's magnificent scenery through the eyes of two very experienced photographers.

Alan Fox spent much of his childhood in the Warrumbungles and his experiences there inspired a lifelong passion for the natural world. There isn't an inch of Australia that Alan hasn't visited. Through his lens he has captured the wonder of many of our most famous natural wonders including Uluru, Kakadu and the Great Barrier Reef.

Esther Beaton has also travelled Australia, both writing and photographing for the Australian Geographic, the Good Weekend, the Australian Women's Weekly and House and Garden. Esther has 23 years experience as a nature photographer and is a champion of Australia's wildlife.

The workshop will suit anybody with a broad interest in nature and photography. It will culminate in a historic photo shoot on the final day where we will attempt to capture 'a day in the life of the park' - a pictorial record of the park 50 years after it was established.

The cost of the course will be \$290 which includes accommodation and meals at the nearby Warrumbungles Holiday Camp. Numbers will be strictly limited and bookings are essential. Bookings can be made by phoning the Visitor Centre on 68 254 364.
